The glowing embrace of more *Friendship*, more *Connection*, and more *Support* now reaches an ever-expanding number of children and families. As Friendship Circle edges toward the goal of welcoming 360 participants, its capacity, too, has expanded, introducing additional staff, launching exciting new programs, and streamlining operations.

Friendship Circle is enhancing its regular programming by blending friendship and developmental education—social and physical. Programs, now totaling 14, complemented by various camps and events, now include Dance, Social Skills, and more! Plus, the innovative Individualized Friendship Plan not only helps children learn social skills but also facilitates their application during social programs. For instance, a child can learn a new introduction method during Social Skills and then receive assistance practicing during Sunday Circle, offering a smoothly integrated and supportive approach to achieving developmental milestones.

Friendship Circle now offers two enriching Jewish programs with Rabbi Yosef Peysin, PhD, BCBA-D., designed to weave together Jewish values, knowledge, love, and friendship, energizing our connection. In Kulanu Hebrew School, children rotate between personalized Jewish tutoring, socializing, and Judaic activities like music or art. Additionally, teens are equipped with more resources to evolve into better prepared Friend-Makers, ensuring a deeper, more meaningful connection between friends.

Recognizing the additional burden on the family unit that can arise while raising a child with disabilities, and seeing firsthand the challenges wrought by COVID-19, Friendship Circle expanded its services to include family support. Programs and services include parent networking, inspirational events, one-onone coaching, referrals to recommended community services, holiday events for the entire family, parent date-nights, and much more. Furthermore, a newly appointed full-time Clinical Director now provides care and guidance for children, ensuring consistent and professional support every day.
